AN ORDINANCE to amend "The Towns Definition Ordinance, 1883."

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Towns ^{Short title,} Definition Amendment Ordinance, 1898."

It shall be read as one with "The Towns Defini- ^{Construction.} tion Ordinance, 1883," hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

2. The following shall be read as part of the Schedule of the Principal Ordinance:—

The Town of Conva bounded as follows:—

Boundaries
of Conva.*North*—Lands of Exchange and Perseverance Estates.*South*—Lands of Brechin Castle and Exchange Estates.*East*—Lands of Camden Estate.*West*—Lands of Perseverance Estate.Boundaries of
Peru Village.

Peru Village bounded as follows:—

North.—Maraval Ward.*South*.—The Sea.*East*.—The Maraval River.*West*.—The Extravaganza Estate and the Fort George Road.

Savings.

3. The amendment enacted by this Ordinance shall not affect any license commencing whether by virtue of any grant or renewal before the First day of January, 1899.

Passed in Council this Fourteenth day of November, in the year of Our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-eight.
