**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Service <sup>Title.</sup> Widows' and Orphans' Fund Amendment Ordinance, 1898," and shall be read together with "The Public Service Widows' and Orphans' Fund Ordinance, 1898,"<sup>1</sup> hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance and together with the Principal Ordinance may be cited as the Public Service Widows' and Orphans' Fund Ordinances, 1898.

<sup>1</sup> 2. In the eleventh line of Section 22 of the Principal Ordinance the word "being" shall be read as inserted <sup>Amendment Section 22.</sup> before the word "subject."

3. In the eighth line of Section 23 of the Principal Ordinance, the word "or" shall be omitted.

4. In Section 50 of the Principal Ordinance all words of the said section following the word "Council" in the fourteenth line shall be omitted.
