AN ORDINANCE to amend the law relating to the office of Registrar-General.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as “ The Registrar-General Amendment Ordinance, 1898.” Short title.

2. Sections 3 and 7 of Ordinance No. 12 of 1847 and Sections 7 and 8 of Ordinance No. 44 of 1895 are hereby repealed. Repeal.

3. There shall be allowed to the person holding the office of Registrar-General an annual salary at such rate as the Governor shall from time to time direct and as may be allowed by the Legislative Council. Salary of Registrar General.

4. The Governor may appoint any person being a Barrister or Certificated Conveyancer to act as Legal Adviser to the Registrar-General at such salary or Appointment of Legal Adviser.

honorarium as the Governor shall direct, who shall not be required to attend at the office of the Registrar-General except when required so to do by the Registrar-General for the purpose of receiving instructions.

The provisions of Section 10 of Ordinance 44 of 1895 shall not apply to such person.

Duties of Legal
Adviser.

5. The Legal Adviser to the Registrar-General shall advise in all cases free of charge to the Department, and shall, when required, act as Examiner of Titles within the meaning of Ordinance 44 of 1895 without additional fee. Provided that in any action or other proceeding brought against the Registrar-General under the provisions of the Real Property Ordinance, 1895, such Legal Adviser if a Solicitor shall act as Solicitor for the Registrar-General and may receive for his own use without accounting for the same the proper Solicitors' fees and costs of such action or proceeding when the same are allowed out of any fund in Court or directed to be paid by any party thereto other than the Registrar-General.
