AN ORDINANCE to make provision for the payment of the sum of Nine Hundred and Seventy-five Pounds Sterling to the Widow of George Lewis Garcia, late Attorney-General.

WHEREAS on the twenty-ninth November, 1897, it was unanimously resolved by the Governor in Legislative Council to recommend the payment of the gratuity to which his length of service would have had he lived entitled the late Attorney-General of the Colony: Be it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:

1. Notwithstanding the provisions contained in Section 14 of "The Civil Service Widows' and Orphans' Fund Ordinance, 1890," it shall be lawful for the Governor by warrant under his hand to order the pay-

ment of the sum of £975 Sterling out of the Public Moneys of the Island of Trinidad to Marie Angeline Garcia, widow of George Lewis Garcia, late Attorney-General of the Colony.
