AN ORDINANCE to amend "The Registrar's Accounts Audit Ordinance, 1893."

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may for all purposes be cited as Short title.
"The Registrar's Accounts Audit Amendment Ordinance, 1895." Construction.

This Ordinance shall be read and construed as one with "The Registrar's Accounts Audit Ordinance, 1893," hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

The Principal Ordinance and this Ordinance may together be cited as "The Registrar's Accounts Audit Ordinances, 1893 and 1895."

Repeal.
Registrar of

2. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—

5. The Registrar of the Supreme Court shall, in the months of January and July in each year publish in the *Royal Gazette* a Return of all unclaimed suitors' moneys paid into the Treasury by the Court; and of all moneys in deposit to the credit of Bankrupt Estates, and also a Return of Infants' moneys invested by Order of the Supreme Court.
