AN ORDINANCE for postponing the coming into operation of "The Summary Conviction Offences (Procedure) Ordinance, 1895" (No. 47—1895.)

WHEREAS by Section 167 of "The Summary Conviction Offences (Procedure) Ordinance, 1895," it is enacted that the said Ordinance shall come into operation on the first day of May one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six.

And whereas it is expedient that the coming into operation of the said Ordinance should be postponed: Be it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. Section 167 of "The Summary Conviction Offences (Procedure) Ordinance, 1895," is hereby repealed.

2. "The Summary Conviction Offences (Procedure) Ordinance, 1895" shall come into operation on such day as the Governor may by Proclamation under his hand and the seal of the Colony appoint.
