AN ORDINANCE to amend "The Reformatory Schools Ordinances, 1890."—(1-1890 and 36-1890.)

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Reformatory Short title. Schools Amendment Ordinance, 1896."

"The Reformatory Schools Ordinances, 1890" and this Ordinance may together be cited as "The Reformatory Schools Ordinances, 1890—1896."

2. Section 4 of "The Reformatory Schools (amendment) Ordinance, 1890," is hereby amended by the addition of the following words at the end thereof, that is to say:—

Provided that if he shall see fit it shall be lawful for the Governor at any time after the date of such

order by writing under his hand to disallow such order, and from the date of such disallowance such order shall be of no force or effect, and any child who shall be detained thereunder shall forthwith be discharged from such Reformatory.
