AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Ordinance No. 5 of 1873, intituled "An Ordinance to regulate the Salary of Officers Administering the Government of Trinidad and for other purposes."

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Governor's Short title. Salary Ordinance, 1896."

It shall be read as one with the Ordinances Nos. 5 of Construction 1873 and 12 of 1881, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinances.

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Principal Ordinances or in "The Governor's Leave of Absence Ordinance, 1895" (28—1895) whenever the

Governor takes leave of absence under the provisions of any of the said Ordinances one-fifth of his salary during the period of such leave shall be paid to the Officer Administering the Government for the time being in addition to the other emoluments enjoyed by such Officer.
