**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. It shall be lawful for the Council of the Borough of Port-of-Spain to appropriate a sum not exceeding Five Hundred Pounds (£500) of the funds of the said Borough towards defraying the expenses which may be incurred by the Mayor of the said Borough in connexion
