BE it enacted by His Excellency the Acting Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as “The Port-of-Spain Buildings Improvement Ordinance, 1896,” and shall be read as one with “The Port-of-Spain Buildings Improvement Ordinance, 1895.”
