AN ORDINANCE to relieve the Mayor and Burgesses of the Borough of San Fernando from the payment of certain registration charges.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. The following Sub-section shall be read after Sub-section (*d*) of Section 1 of the Ordinance No. 3 of 1891: Relief from registration charges.

(*e.*) The obligation imposed by the Sections 13 and 23 of Ordinance No. 13 of 1847 intituled “An Ordinance for registering Births, Deaths, and Marriages” upon the Town Clerk of the said Borough of San Fernando to pay from the funds of such Borough the amounts made by the said Sections of the said Ordinance payable respectively to the Registrar-General in respect of books

and forms furnished to the Superintendent Registrar of Births and Deaths, and to the Registrars of Births and Deaths in respect of the registration of Births and Deaths, which said amounts shall hereafter be payable to such Registrar-General and Registrars respectively from general revenue.

Passed in Council this Nineteenth day of August, in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five.
