Hucksters, Porters and Carters Licensing (San Fernando).

AN ORDINANCE to amend “The Hucksters, Porters and Carters Licensing Ordinance, 1887.”

WHEREAS doubts have arisen as to the meaning of Section 4 of the Ordinance No. 7 of 1887; and whereas it is desirable to alter the fees payable for certain Licenses and the fares respectively chargeable thereunder: Be it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. The fourth Section of the Ordinance No. 7 of 1887, ^{Repeal.} intituled “An Ordinance for regulating the Licensing of Hucksters, Porters and Carters plying within the limits of the Borough of San Fernando” (hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance), is hereby repealed, and in place and stead thereof shall be read the following:—

Unless the License from the Council of the said Borough under the hand of the Town Clerk and Treasurer of such Borough shall have first been obtained it shall not be lawful for any person

- (1.) To ply, hire or engage himself as a Porter for hire or reward either on shore within the limits aforesaid or in any boat or vessel within the limits aforesaid or in any boat or vessel within the harbour of San Fernando.
- (2.) To follow the trade or business of a Pedlar or Travelling Huckster, and as such Pedlar or Travelling Huckster to sell or barter, or offer or expose for sale or barter any merchandize, goods or provisions, save and except the merchandize, goods, provisions and other things specified in the First Schedule of the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) Being the owner of any cart or hand cart to keep or use or to allow to be kept or used any such cart or hand cart within the limits of the said Borough.

Any person acting in contravention of this Section shall be guilty of an offence punishable on Summary Conviction, and shall be liable for each offence to a penalty not exceeding Ten Pounds, and in default of immediate payment shall be imprisoned with or without hard labour for any term not exceeding three calendar months.

This Section shall not apply to any person who resides without the limits of San Fernando and uses or

allows to be used any cart *bona fide* his property for the purpose of carrying his own goods, produce or supplies into or from the said Borough.

2. The Second and Third Schedules of the Principal Ordinance are also hereby repealed, and in place and stead thereof respectively shall be read the Schedules "A" and "B" hereto. Repeal.

3. This Ordinance and the Principal Ordinance shall be read and construed together as one Ordinance. Construction.

Passed in Council this Twenty-fourth day of June, in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five.

| From or to Cipro-street, the remainder of Coffee-street, Royal Road and Circular Road between Pointe-à-Pierre and the nearest boundary of the Vista Bella Estate... | 30 " |
| From or to Circular Road beyond the point before mentioned | 40 " |
| From or to any place not herein specially mentioned, for every one thousand yards (1,000 yards) | 24 " |

SCHEDULE "B."

FEES PAYABLE FOR LICENSES.

| Donkey and Hand Carts. | { | Five dollars per annum or one dollar and fifty cents for each quarter of a year. |
| Other Carts. | { | Ten dollars per annum or three dollars for each quarter of a year. |
| Porters, Pedlars and Hucksters. | { | One dollar and twenty cents per annum or thirty cents for each quarter of a year. |

Licenses for a year are to terminate on the 31st day of December.

Quarterly Licenses are to terminate on the 31st March, 30th June, 30th September, and 31st December.
