AN ORDINANCE to amend the law as to the fees payable to Commissioners of Affidavits.

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Affidavit Fees Short title. Ordinance, 1895.

This Ordinance shall be read as one with the Construction. Stamp (Fees) Ordinances, 1885 and 1886 (11-1885 and 23-1886).

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 51 of Ordinance 4-1848 all fees in respect of affidavits sworn before any person holding any of the offices mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall be collected by means of stamps and shall be paid into the Colonial Treasury.
