AN ORDINANCE to amend the Law relating to Quarantine.

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to amend the Law relating Preamble.  
to Quarantine: Be it therefore enacted by the  
Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and  
consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may for all purposes be cited as Short title.  
“The Quarantine Ordinance, 1893.”

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation and take Commencement  
effect on such day as may be appointed by the Governor  
by Proclamation.

3. In this Ordinance unless the context otherwise re- Interpretation.  
quires, the following terms shall have the meanings herein-  
after respectively assigned to them, that is to say:—

The term “Infectious Disease” means Cholera,  
Yellow Fever, Small-pox and any other epi-  
demic disease declared by the Governor and  
Executive Council to be infectious.

The term "Infected Place" means any port or place—

- (a.) Where an infectious disease as defined in this Ordinance exists at the time of the arrival in this Colony of any vessel therefrom or where any such infectious disease has existed at the time of the departure of any vessel therefrom or within a period of thirty days previous to such departure, or
- (b.) Which has been declared by the Governor and Executive Council to be an infected place.

The term "Infected Vessel" means—

- (a.) Every vessel which shall have arrived from an infected place as above defined after an absence therefrom of less than thirty days.
- (b.) Every vessel which shall have communicated with an infected place or with an infected vessel as defined in this Ordinance and shall have arrived in this Colony within thirty days from such communication.
- (c.) Every vessel on board of which there is any person who or any article or thing which has been within the preceding thirty days in an infected place or in an infected vessel.
- (d.) Every vessel on board of which there is or on any of the preceding thirty days there has been any person suffering from infectious disease.
- (e.) Every vessel on board of which there is any article or thing which has been or may be suspected to have been used or handled by any person suffering from infectious disease and which has not been cleansed and disinfected as required by this Ordinance.
