AN ORDINANCE to provide for the payment into the Colonial Treasury of fees received by the Registrar-General as District Registrar of Marriages of Port-of-Spain.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. All fees heretofore received by the Registrar-General as District Registrar of Marriages under Section 38 of the Ordinance No. 11 of 1863, intituled "An Ordinance to amend the Law with regard to the Solemnization and Registration of Marriages," and hereinafter called "The Principal Ordinance," shall as from the 12th day of April now last past be paid by such Registrar into the Colonial Treasury for the use of Her Majesty.

Repeal. 2. Section 38 of "The Principal Ordinance," so far as relates to fees payable to the Registrar-General as District Registrar of Port-of-Spain, is hereby repealed.

Construction. 3. This Ordinance shall be read and construed as one with "The Principal Ordinance."
