AN ORDINANCE to amend "The Coroners Ordinance,
1881."

Adm. Ord. No. 2 of 1893

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows :—

1. Section 13 of "The Coroners Ordinance, 1881," is hereby repealed, and instead thereof shall be read the following :—

Repeal of Section 13 of Ordinance No. 2 of 1881.

"Every District Medical Officer or his substitute shall
"be entitled to receive in respect of the body of any
"deceased person viewed by him the sum of one pound
"for the report which he is by this Ordinance required to
"make to the Coroner and for the anatomical examination
"(if any) of such body the further sum of one pound, and
"shall also be bound if required by the Coroner to attend
"as a witness before the Coroner without further fee or

“allowance, except such allowance for mileage as the
“Governor from time to time either by general regulations
“or in particular cases appoints. Money payable under
“this Section shall be paid out of the Colonial Treasury
“under such regulations as the Governor from time to
“time appoints.”
