AN ORDINANCE to amend the Stamp Duty Ordinance,  
1908.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Stamp Duty Short Title. (Amendment) Ordinance, 1913.
2. Section 35 of the Stamp Duty Ordinance, 1908, is amended by striking out all after "Section 16" in line 3 and inserting in lieu thereof the words "of the Solicitors Ordinance, 1912." Amendment of Section 35 of Ordinance 23-1908.
3. The Schedule to Stamp Duty Ordinance, 1908, is amended Amendment of Schedule to Ordinance 28-1908.
  - (a.) By striking out the figures "£12 10 0," being the stamp duty payable on "Admission of any person as a Solicitor" and substituting therefor the figures "£25 0 0."

(b.) By striking out the figures "£10 0 0," being the stamp duty payable on "articles of clerkship" and substituting therefor the figures "£30 0 0."
