AN ORDINANCE to amend the Summary Convictions
(Offences) Ordinance.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Summary Convictions (Offences) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1913. Short Title.

2. Section 79 of the Summary Convictions (Offences) Ordinance (No. 5) is amended by striking out all after the word "goods" in line 10 thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the words "he shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding £20 or to imprisonment, with or without hard labour, for any term not exceeding six months." Amendment of Section 79 of No. 5.

3. Section 80 of the Summary Convictions (Offences) Ordinance (No. 5) is amended by inserting the words "or placing" after the word "concealment" in line 16 thereof. Amendment of Section 80 of No. 5.
