AN ORDINANCE to amend the Local Forces Ordinance,  
No. 131.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Local Forces Short Title.  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1913.

2. Section 31 of the Local Forces Ordinance is amended by striking out all after the word "impress" in line 4 thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the words "men, boats, vehicles in whatsoever manner propelled, drawn, or moved, horses, mules, donkeys or cattle, as the service may require." Amendment of Section 31 of No. 131.
