AN ORDINANCE to amend the Diseased Animals Ordinance (No. 245).

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Diseased Animals Short Title. (Amending) Ordinance, 1913.

2. Section 3 of the Diseased Animals Ordinance (No. 245) Amendment of Section 3 of No. 245. is amended by striking out the words "and to the owner thereof" at the end of the said section.

3. Section 6 of the Diseased Animals Ordinance (No. 245) Amendment of Section 6 of No. 245. is amended by inserting after the words "owner thereof" in line 4, the words "or if such owner does not pay to the Society the cost of the keep and treatment of such animal during the period that it is detained as aforesaid."

Regulations.

4. The Governor in Executive Council may make regulations prescribing the scale of charges for the treatment and keep of animals under the provisions of the Diseased Animals Ordinance (No. 245.)
