AN ORDINANCE relating to the sale of Compounds of
Spirits.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Spirit Compounds Short title. Ordinance 1909.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Liquor Licenses Ordinance No. 177, Compounds as defined in Section 2 of the Spirits and Spirit Compounds Ordinance No. 176 and which are manufactured in the Colony may be sold by Spirit dealers within the meaning of the said Ordinance No. 177 in any quantity not less than one gallon to one person at the same time.

Passed in Council this sixth day of December, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and nine.
