AN ORDINANCE to amend the Board of Agriculture Ordinance 1908 (35-1908).

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Board of Agriculture Ordinance 1910. The Ordinances Nos. 35-1908 and 16-1909 and this Ordinance may together be cited as the Board of Agriculture Ordinances 1908-10. Short title.

2. After the word "statistics" in the last line of Sub-section (1) of Section 4 of Ordinance No. 35-1908, shall be read the following :— Appropriation of funds.

"and for the purposes of agricultural education,
 "improved methods of cultivation, exhibitions
 "of stock and agricultural products and all
 "matters and things incidental or appertaining
 "to agriculture in such manner as the Board
 "shall think desirable."
