AN ORDINANCE to amend the Interpretation Ordinance No. 137.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Interpretation Short title. Ordinance 1910.
2. In all Ordinances, and in all legal documents, whether passed or made before or after the commencement of this Ordinance, the term "the Government Analyst" shall include any Assistant or other Analyst employed by the Government. Government Analyst.
