AN ORDINANCE relating to the attachment of Debts in

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Attachment of Short title.
Debts Ordinance, 1910.
2. Ordinance No. 24 of 1909 is hereby repealed. Repeal.
3. No order for the attachment of the wages of any Wages of
servant, labourer or workman shall be made by any Court workmen.
of civil jurisdiction in this Colony.
4. No order for the attachment of any money payable to Moneys due to
any contractor or any other person in respect of work contractor.
done for the Government or any department thereof shall
be made by any Court of civil jurisdiction in this Colony
unless it be made to appear to the satisfaction of the Judge
to whom application for such order is made that all wages

due to the labourers employed by any such contractor or other person in and upon the work in respect of which payment of the amount sought to be attached is due have been fully paid and satisfied.
