AN ORDINANCE to amend the Lepers Ordinance
No. 190.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Lepers Ordinance 1911. It shall be read as one with the Lepers Ordinance No. 190.

Prohibited trades.

2. The following shall be read at the end and as part of the Schedule to the Ordinance No. 190:—

Boatman,
Sailor,
Schoolmaster,
Teacher,

or any trade, occupation, employment or calling in which the person employed comes in contact with other persons.
