AN ORDINANCE to amend the Food and Drugs Ordinance, No. 162.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Food and Drugs Ordinance, 1911.

Fines for milk adulteration.

2. Lines 25 to 29 of Section 8 of Ordinance No. 162, both inclusive, are hereby repealed and the following words shall be inserted in lieu thereof:—

In cases of milk adulteration by added water forfeit and pay for every one per cent. of added water a penalty of ten shillings for a first offence and of one pound for a second offence, and for a third

or subsequent offence be liable to imprisonment with hard labour for a period not exceeding six months for one per cent. or more of added water.

Passed in Council this thirty-first day of May, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eleven.
