**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Quarantine <sup>Citation.</sup> (Amendment) Ordinance, 1911, and shall be read as one with the Quarantine Ordinance, 1910 (17-1910).

2. Section .6 of the Quarantine Ordinance, 1910, is hereby repealed and there shall be substituted for it the following Section:—

6. It is hereby declared that the Governor is the proper authority to give the notifications and the particulars specified in Article 2 and the infor- <sup>Governor to give information required by Convention.</sup>
