Board of Education (Validation).

AN ORDINANCE to validate and confirm certain proceedings of the Board of Education.

WHEREAS by Section 3 of the Elementary Education Ordinance (No. 147) it is among other things enacted that the Board of Education shall consist of the Governor as President and fourteen persons appointed by the Governor, and that six of the said fourteen members shall be persons professing the Roman Catholic Religion and the remaining eight members shall be persons not so professing;

And whereas the said Board has met and transacted business on several occasions when the said Board has not been constituted in accordance with the above recited provisions;

And whereas it is expedient to validate and confirm the proceedings of the said Board on the said several occasions;

Be it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof

as follows : That all proceedings of the Board of Education at the meetings of the said Board on the 29th day of September, the 28th day of October, the 24th day of November and the 30th day of December, in the year 1903 ; the 26th day of January, the 29th day of March, the 26th day of April, the 31st day of May, the 29th day of June, the 26th day of July, and the 23rd day of August in the year 1904 ; and on the 24th day of April, the 29th day of May and the 30th day of July in the year 1906, are hereby confirmed and declared to be valid to all intents and purposes as if the said Board had at the respective times of the said meetings been constituted in accordance with the above recited provisions of Section 3 of the said Ordinance No. 147.

Passed in Council this Fifth day of November, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and six.
