AN ORDINANCE to amend the Summary Conviction
Offences (Procedure) Ordinance (No. 1).

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Summary Convic- Short titles.
tion Offences (Procedure) Ordinance 1906.

The Ordinances Nos. 1 and 276 of the revised edition,
Nos. 2 and 27 of 1905 and this Ordinance may together be
cited as the Summary Conviction Offences (Procedure)
Ordinances.

2. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 1 is hereby repealed and in Repeal.
lieu thereof shall be read the following :—

His Majesty may from time to time by Warrant under Appointment
the hand of the Governor and the seal of the Colony appoint of S.J.P. and
Stipendiary Justices of the Peace ; and in case of the death, Acting S.J.P.
retirement, suspension or removal from office, absence on
leave or on special duty or unavoidable absence from any

cause of any Stipendiary Justice, may appoint some other person to be or to act as a Stipendiary Justice in his place.

Every Stipendiary Justice shall hold office during His Majesty's pleasure.
