AN ORDINANCE to amend the Elementary Education Ordinances Nos. 147 and 238.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Elementary Edu- Short Title.
cation Ordinance, 1906.

The Elementary Education Ordinances (Nos. 147 and 238) and this Ordinance may together be cited as the Elementary Education Ordinances, 1905-6.

2. Sub-section 3 of Section 12 of the Elementary Educa- Repeal.
tion Ordinance (No. 147) is hereby repealed and in lieu thereof shall be read the following :

(3.) There shall attach to the Local Managers of Managers of
Assisted Schools with respect to the school or schools under assisted
their management the same duties as are by Sub-section (2) schools.
of Section 11 of this Ordinance prescribed for the Local Managers of Government Schools.

Provided that it shall be the duty of the Local Managers of Assisted Schools to hold regular quarterly meetings for the consideration of questions affecting the staff, buildings, apparatus and general welfare of the school or schools under their management, and to keep records of their proceedings in minute books which they shall provide for the purpose.

Irregular attendance at quarterly meetings shall be one of the causes for requiring the retirement of any Local Manager.

No teacher or any person who derives any profit or emolument from any assisted School shall be a Local Manager.

Where an Assisted School is conducted by or in connection with any religious denomination, the Head or Governing Body of such religious denomination shall have the power at any time to appoint Local Managers for such school or to require the retirement of any such Local Manager. Provided that the Board of Education may require the retirement of any Local Manager.

The appointment of any Local Manager together with the acceptance thereof in writing by the person so appointed and the notification of retirement of any Local Manager shall be delivered to the Secretary of the Board of Education.
