AN ORDINANCE to amend the Pilots Ordinance, No. 183.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Pilots Ordinance Short title.
1907.

2. The following shall be read as part of Sub-section (6) Violent language.
of Section 22 of the Pilots Ordinance (No. 183):

Or uses obscene indecent or violent language to a Harbour Master or Warden or to any assistant or representative of such Harbour Master or Warden.

3. The following shall be read as part of the said Section 22 immediately after Sub-section (11) thereof: Fraudulently obtaining charge of vessel.

(12.) By wilful misrepresentation obtains or endeavours to obtain the charge of any vessel.
