AN ORDINANCE to amend the Weights and Measures Ordinance, No. 108.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Weights and Measures Ordinance 1907.

2. In lieu of the Fifth Schedule to the Weights and Measures Ordinance (No. 108) shall be read the following: Avoirdupois weights.
