AN ORDINANCE to amend the Dog License Ordinances,
Nos. 143 and 237.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Dog License Ordinance 1907. Short title.

2. Sections 4, 5, 6, 8 and 10 of Ordinance No. 143 and Ordinance No. 237 shall not be in force except during such periods as the Governor in Executive Council may from time to time by proclamation direct. Suspension of clauses relating to badges.

3. Every proclamation issued under the provisions of this Ordinance shall be published in the *Royal Gazette*, and production of a copy of such *Gazette* purporting to contain a copy of any such proclamation shall be sufficient evidence of the tenor and issuing thereof. Publication and evidence.
