AN ORDINANCE to amend the San Fernando and Arima Hucksters Porters and Carters Ordinance (No. 151).

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the San Fernando and Arima Hucksters Porters and Carters Ordinance: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. The last paragraph of the 4th section of the San Fernando and Arima Hucksters Porters and Carters Ordinance (No. 151) is hereby repealed and in lieu thereof shall be substituted the following:—

“This section shall not apply to any person who resides without the limits of the Borough of San Fernando and uses or allows to be used any cart *bona fide* his property for the purpose of carrying his own goods, produce or supplies into or from the said Borough.”

Private carts in San Fernando.

Repeal. 2. The part of Schedule II to the said Ordinance which relates to fees payable for licenses in the Borough of Arima is hereby repealed and in lieu thereof shall be substituted the following :—

License fees. In the Borough of Arima :—

Porters Pedlars and Hucksters (Other than Pedlars and Hucksters of marketable commodities).	}	Five Shillings per annum. One Shilling and Six Pence for every quarter of a year (when such license is taken for less than a year).

For every cart plying for hire or reward, Two Pounds and Ten Shillings per annum, or (where the license is for less than a year) Fifteen Shillings for a quarter of a year.

For every cart not plying for hire or reward, One Pound per annum, or (where the license is for less than a year) Six Shillings for a quarter of a year.

For every handcart, Five Shillings per annum, or (where the license is for less than a year) One Shilling and Six Pence for a quarter of a year.

(Where the cart to be licensed is a donkey cart, only one-half of the fees specified above is to be payable).

Construction. 3. This Ordinance shall be read as one with the San
Fernando and Arima Hucksters Porters and Carters
Short title. Ordinance and may be cited as the "San Fernando and
Arima Hucksters Porters and Carters (Amending) Ordinance 1907."

Passed in Council this Twenty-fifth day of March, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seven.
