AN ORDINANCE to amend the Coroners Ordinance, No. 8.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Coroners Ordinance, 1907. Short title.

2. The following shall be read at the end and as part of Section 5 of Ordinance No. 8:— D.M.O. may order removal without viewing body.

Provided that the Medical Officer of the District may, in cases where there are no circumstances of suspicion and where he is unable to view the body within a reasonable time, order the removal of such body to such place as may be named by him.

Passed in Council this Eleventh day of March, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seven.
