AN ORDINANCE to amend the Plant Protection Ordinance, No. 126.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Plant Protection Ordinance 1907. Short title.

2. The following shall be read at the end and as part of Section 3 of the Plant Protection Ordinance, No. 126. Importation subject to conditions.

Provided nevertheless that the Governor may from time to time with the advice of the Executive Council by Proclamation similarly published order that any tree, plant or vegetable as defined by Section 2 of Ordinance No. 127 and any earth or soil, packages or coverings or such other articles or things as may be named or specified in such proclamation may only be imported into the Colony subject to such conditions as may be directed or mentioned therein.
