AN ORDINANCE to amend the Land Charges and Land Taxes Ordinance, No. 204.



G o v e r n o r .

19th February, 1907.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

Section 41 of the Land Charges and Land Taxes ^{Repeal.} Ordinance (No. 204) is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following :—

If any person, the owner or tenant of any lands in ^{Quit rent.} this Colony subject to the payment of any annual quit rent to His Majesty the King, shall at any one time pay into the hands of the Sub-Intendant a sum of money equal in amount to twelve years quit rent of such lands, such

payment shall be taken as a sufficient redemption of the quit rent payable in respect of such lands, including arrears if any, and the said lands shall from thenceforth be and be deemed to be wholly discharged for ever from such quit rent.
