AN ORDINANCE to amend the Immigration Ordinance,
No. 161.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Immigration Ordinance 1908. It shall be read with the Immigration Ordinance No. 161 and the Immigration (Amendment) Ordinance 1905 (22-1905).

Rate of wages
for task work.

2. The following section shall be read after Section 117 of the Immigration Ordinance No. 161:

In the computation of the average rate of wages payable for task work for the purpose of the preceding section, there shall be taken into account the value of free quarters for and medical attendance on immigrants during their terms of service, upon such scale as may be fixed from time to time by the Governor in Executive Council.

3. In Section 117 of the Immigration Ordinance No. 161, ^{Amendment of} in the proviso, for the words "the wages" shall be read the ^{Section 117.} words "the money wage."
