AN ORDINANCE to amend the Public Health Ordinance, No. 187.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Health Ordinance 1907. Short title.

2. The following shall be read after the words "Ward Union" in Section 5 of the Public Health Ordinance No. 187: Ward Officers to be Assistant Inspectors.

"and his Ward Officers shall be Assistant Sanitary Inspectors for such Ward Union."

3. In Sections 10, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 22, 47, 53, 54 and 56 of the Public Health Ordinance (No. 187) the term "Warden" shall be deemed to include "Ward Officer." "Warden" to include Ward Officer.
