AN ORDINANCE to amend the Petty Civil Courts Ordinance, No. 54.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Petty Civil Courts (Amendment) Ordinance 1907, and shall be read and construed along with the Petty Civil Courts Ordinance No. 54, and the Petty Civil Courts (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 298. Short title.
Construction.

2. Section 27 of the Ordinance No. 54 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following *proviso*:— Section 27 of
Ordinance 54
amended.

“ Provided that applications for leave to serve out of
“ the district under Section 14 hereof, and appli-
“ cations to sue any person not resident in the
“ district under Section 15 hereof, shall not be
“ made in open Court; but such applications
“ may be made in writing in the forms in the

“ Schedule annexed hereto ; and a fee of sixpence
 “ shall be payable in respect of the filing of
 “ every such application.”
