AN ORDINANCE to amend the Summary Conviction Offences (Procedure) Ordinance, No. 1.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Summary Conviction Offences (Procedure) Ordinance 1907. It shall be read with the following Ordinances, viz.: the Magisterial Procedure Ordinance (No. 276), Nos. 2 and 27 of 1905 and 26 of 1906. Short title.

2. Sub-section (3) of Section 78 of Ordinance No. 1 shall be read with the omission of all the words following the word "prescribed" in the seventh line thereof. Amendment of Section 78 of No. 1.

3. In Section 105 of Ordinance No. 1, in lieu of "101" shall be read "103." Correction of misprint.

4. In Section 107 of Ordinance No. 1, after the words "or either of them" shall be read the words "with or without a surety or sureties." Sureties for good behaviour.
