AN ORDINANCE relating to the Pensions and contributions to the Widows' and Orphans' Fund of certain Emigration Officers.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Emigration Officers (Pensions) Ordinance 1907. Short title.

2.—(1.) An Emigration Officer in India whose emoluments are paid jointly by this Colony and other Colonies and whose post is declared to be pensionable, shall be entitled in respect of his service in India to a pension from the funds of this Colony which shall bear the same proportion to that to which he would have been entitled had the whole of his emoluments been paid by this Colony, as the aggregate amount of the salary which he has drawn from this Colony bears to the total sum made up of such aggregate amount and the aggregate amounts received from such other Colonies.
