AN ORDINANCE relating to the payment of drawback on Petroleum.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Petroleum (Drawback) Ordinance 1909.

Repeal.
Duty on petroleum.

2. The Ordinance No. 30—1908 is hereby repealed, and from and after the commencement of this Ordinance the duty on petroleum shall be that prescribed by the Customs Duties Ordinance No. 179, or any Ordinance amending or replacing the same.

Interpretation.

3. In this Ordinance and in all rules and regulations made hereunder the term "petroleum" shall have the meaning given to the terms "petroleum" and "dangerous petroleum" by the Petroleum Ordinance 1909 (No. 14—1909.)

4. Persons using petroleum as a source of mechanical power shall be entitled to drawback of duties at a rate per gallon equal to the difference between the duty per gallon on such petroleum and two-pence on all such petroleum which has been used as a source of mechanical power, subject to such rules and regulations as to security and otherwise in that behalf as may from time to time be made by the Collector of Customs with the approval of the Governor in Executive Council.

Rules and

All such rules and regulations shall be published in the *Royal Gazette*. Production of a copy of the *Royal Gazette* containing a copy of any such rules and regulations shall in all legal proceedings be *prima facie* evidence of the due making and tenor of such rules and regulations.
