AN ORDINANCE to amend the Pensions Ordinance,
No. 175.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Pensions Ordinance 1908. It shall be read as one with the Pensions Ordinance No. 175, the Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance 1905 (29—1905), and the Pensions Ordinance 1907 (37—1907). Short title.
Construction.

2. In Section 8 of the Pensions Ordinance No. 175, after the words "Colonial Government" shall be read the words "or of the Government of India." Amendment of
Section 8 of
Ord. No. 175.

3. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have commenced on the twentieth day of November, 1900. Ordinance
retrospective.
