AN ORDINANCE to amend the Public Health Ordinance
No. 187.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Health Short title. Ordinance, 1908. It shall be read as one with the Public Health Ordinance No. 187 and the Public Health Ordinance 1907 (No. 33-1907).

2. Section 8 of the Public Health Ordinance No. 187 is Repeal. hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—

8. The Board shall have a seal to be approved by the Meetings of Board. Governor, and shall meet in the Public Buildings in the Town of Port-of-Spain, on the first Monday of each month, and oftener if need be on the summons of the Surgeon-General, and may adjourn to any other day; and any three members of the Board shall be a quorum for the despatch of business; and at every meeting the Governor, or in his absence the Surgeon-General, or if he be not present then such member of the Board as the members present may appoint as chairman, shall preside.
