AN ORDINANCE to amend the Education Ordinances
1890-1902.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Education Ordinance 1903. The Education Ordinances 1890-1902 and this Ordinance may together be cited as the Education Ordinances 1890-1903. Short title.

2. Paragraph (a) of Sub-section (1) of Section 12 of the Elementary Education Ordinance 1890 (17-1890) is hereby repealed and in lieu thereof shall be read the following :— Repeal.

(a.) That the property and control of the school shall be vested in two or more Trustees, who shall be the Local Managers of such school, having the power to appoint and dismiss the teacher or teachers of such school. Property and control of Assisted Schools.

Provided that the consent of the Inspector of Schools shall be required to the appointment of teachers, but that such consent shall not be withheld except on educational grounds :

Provided also that the Board shall have power to require the dismissal of any teacher if the Board shall so think fit :

Provided also that the summary dismissal of a teacher for misconduct shall, on the application of such teacher, be subject to confirmation by the Board.

Passed in Council this Sixth day of July, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and three.
