AN ORDINANCE to make provision for raising a loan for the construction of Main Roads and other public works.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Works Loan Ordinance 1902.

2. It shall be lawful for the Governor at such times and by such instalments as may be deemed expedient to borrow a sum not exceeding £300,000 by the sale of Inscribed Stock under the provisions of "The General Loan and Inscribed Stock Ordinance 1890" (28-1890) to be applied to the following purposes, that is to say:—

- (a.) Main roads,
- (b.) Water works,
- (c.) Harbour works,
- (d.) Sewerage works,

according to the Schedule attached hereto.

Provided that no money be spent on a Slipway (£25,000 in item 3 of Schedule) or on Sewerage Works (item 5), without a special vote of the Legislature.

Passed in Council this Twenty-eighth day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and two.
