AN ORDINANCE relating to Wireless Telegraphy.

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Wireless Tele- Short title.  
graphy Ordinance 1903.

2. It shall not be lawful for any person or corporation to License.  
use or establish in this Colony any apparatus or installation for the purposes of wireless telegraphy, without first obtaining from the Governor a license in that behalf, to be granted on such terms and conditions as the Governor may from time to time prescribe.

3. Any person or corporation contravening the provisions Penalty.  
of the last preceding section shall be guilty of an offence, and on summary conviction thereof shall be liable to a fine of £50, and the apparatus and installation in respect of

which a conviction is obtained may by order of the Stipendiary Justice before whom such conviction is obtained be forfeited to the use of His Majesty the King.
