AN ORDINANCE to amend the Port-of-Spain Corporation
Ordinance, Cap. 224.

[21st March, 1931.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows :—

Short title.
Construction.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Port-of-Spain Corporation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1931, and shall be read as one with the Port-of-Spain Corporation Ordinance, Cap. 224, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

2. The second proviso to section 120 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting the word "recurrent" before the word "expenditure" in the third line and by inserting the words "of recurrent expenditure" at the end thereof.
