AN ORDINANCE to amend the Port-of-Spain Corporation Ordinance, Cap. 224.

[18th December, 1930.]

**B**EF it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Port-of-Spain Short title. Corporation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1930, and shall be read as one with the Port-of-Spain Corporation Ordinance, Cap. 224, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 121 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting after the word "City" in the twentieth line thereof the words "the provision, erection, upkeep, maintenance and management of dwellings for the working classes."
